The defining characteristic: a soft, glowing blue that appears to shimmer, often described as "**blue velvet**." This unique optical effect sets them apart from all other sapphires.

## Silky Inclusions

Fine rutile silk inclusions diffuse light, creating a unique soft sheen. Under magnification, this "**silk**" contributes to the gem's characteristic glow, enhancing its velvety appearance.

## Origin Matters

Only stones verified as **Kashmir-origin** command premium prices. Gems from Pakistani-administered Kashmir are not considered authentic by many collectors and have significantly lower market value.



Top-quality, unheated Kashmir sapphires frequently range from **\$75,000–\$200,000 per carat**. A 2.4-carat unheated gem can command between **\$95,000–\$100,000**.

Larger stones are exceedingly rare and command steep premiums. Even smaller stones (0.5–1 carat) with documented origin can fetch significant prices, depending on their quality, silk, and color saturation.

The extreme scarcity of Kashmir sapphires, with mining ceased over a century ago, drives their exceptional value. Nearly all available stones originate from vintage estate collections, further boosting their rarity.

Cut Style	Antique cuts (cushion, cabochon, sugarloaf) often reflect period authenticity, adding historical charm.
Size & Rarity	Stones over 5 carats are exceptionally rare and valuable, potentially reaching <b>\$600,000 – \$1.2 million+</b> depending on quality.

## Certified Reports

Stones from Pakistani-administered Kashmir are sometimes mislabeled as "Kashmir sapphires." Verify origin carefully to avoid overpaying.



## Appreciate Vintage Cuts


Older cuts and visible silk can enhance desirability, especially for collectors seeking historically significant pieces and museum-quality specimens.
